

Q1 What is your current level of concern in regards to COVID-19?







Q4 Prior to COVID-19, were you a frequent visitor of Downtown Lynchburg for shopping, eating, entertainment, and services?






Q5 What are your main reasons for visiting Downtown Lynchburg? (check all that apply)

Q8 If local downtown businesses offered their products and services through online shopping, how likely are you to shop with them as opposed to major national or global online retailers?






Q9 What practices would you like to see downtown businesses implementing? (Check all that apply)




Q10 In the coming months, while adhering to appropriate guidelines, how comfortable would you be attending public events?
